I am happy to report that the New York State Assembly passed the Employee Protection Provisions (EPP) bill by a vote of 114 to 12 on Monday night, June 17th.

The New York State Senate previously approved the EPP bill by a 57 to 1 margin.

The bill now goes to Governor Cuomo for his review and hopefully his signature.

We will be working hard with our allies to get the bill signed. We will, of course, keep you advised of all developments.

On another note, as you all know, our election of officers was held yesterday. The three members of the Cordiello Slate on the ballot were elected, receiving some 85% of the vote.

It has been an honor and privilege to serve this membership over the past 10 years. We look forward to working with you over the coming years as we move this Union ahead into the future.
