Latest UBER effort to stop drivers from unionizing

Dear Driver:

Uber recently announced that they have picked a union to establish an "association" for drivers in New York. It is known as the Independent Drivers Guild. We do not know how many drivers were involved in this but we believe it was only a handful at best. Part of Uber's motivation is to squash any union effort from becoming a reality. Uber does not want you to have real power. Uber wants to stop efforts by other unions working to organize drivers -- this agreement is a 5 year lasting agreement without much real power apparently. This will still allow UBER to control the outcome of everything. So, will anything really change for the drivers???

Under the current agreement between UBER and this association the members WILL NOT be able to bargain over a contract with UBER. There will be NO negotiations to stipulate fares, benefits and protections. So, UBER will continue to determine all the elements that affect every single driver on their platform.

In addition to UBER exerting full control, this association will not encourage driver to unionize or -- strike – and it will limit their right to campaign on their own behalf.

So, dear friends and fellow drivers; here is your glimpse into what is really going on. As Uber drivers we have an obligation and a right to unionize to fight for our rights. UBER cannot be allowed to take this away from us! A worker that is well informed will <u>never</u> be exploited.


Dear Drivers:
